### Annual Dyslexia Report 2021-2022 School Year

In accordance with IDOE Dyslexia Guidance and Indiana Code, all school corporations and charter schools in Indiana must annually report dyslexia screening data. All students in kindergarten, grade one, and grade two are screened each school year for learning characteristics related to dyslexia. The selected universal screener used by MVCSC (NWEA Map Fluency) has been approved by the IDOE and meets all requirements listed within the guidance.

**Dyslexia Intervention Program(s):** Mt. Vernon Community School Corporation utilizes the resources below to support students who were identified as “at risk” or “at some risk” for dyslexia during the 21/22 school year.

- **Orton Gillingham:** The Orton-Gillingham approach utilizes evidence-based procedures and activities to maximize the opportunities for students to apply and retain literacy skills.
- **95 Percent Group:** 95 Percent is a comprehensive approach that uses research-based methodologies when implementing RTI/MTSS structures and processes proven to improve intervention success and increases in literacy.

**Number of students who received dyslexia intervention during the previous school year.**

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**The number of students identified with dyslexia during the previous school year.**
